KUZA has operations across Kenya, Uganda, Rwanda, Mozambique, and Tanzania and a network of 750,000 smallholder farmers.

Job Description

- 1. Engage agripreneurs to help them access mentorship & training support to improve their knowledge and skills in agribusiness.
- 2. Conduct group training sessions for agripreneurs on agronomy or business skills.
- 3. Coordinate with the agripreneurs & other stakeholders to aggregate inputs/ output demand, linkage to service providers, and extension services to farmers.
- 4. Guide, monitor & mentor the agripreneurs through their entrepreneurial journey (goals, record keeping, farmer training, and business growth & performance)
- 5. Gather feedback from Agripreneurs and document the same by compiling periodic reports.
